RULES and Regulations

**ALL COMPETITORS ARE LIMITED TO 1 HORSE OR RIDER CHANGE PER DRAFT
NO CHANGES TO DRAFT WILL BE TAKEN FROM 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT TIME.**

Scratching's: Rule D.5

A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program.

If a competitor withdraws between 96 hours (4 days) and 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program \$15 per horse per draft shall be withheld and the balance of the nomination fee refunded.

If a competitor withdraws within 96 hours (4 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program, the entire nomination fee may be retained by the Committee.

If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee.

Junior: Riders to be 8yrs - under 13yrs. Limit of 2 horses. Junior riders are not permitted to ride in open age events

Helmets: must be worn by ALL competitors under the age of 18yrs whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times

RULE 9.4: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of the horse participating.

Stallions: Stallions will be allowed to be unrestrained in panel yards through day light hours ONLY. Only 1 horse is allowed per enclosure. Stallions must be double tied at night time. Panels must be a minimum of 1500mm in height. Panels must be constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of 25mm box/pipe equivalent as a minimum. Panels must be anchored securely to a solid object i.e. truck, post. Juniors and Juveniles are not permitted to ride/handle stallions at any time. Electric tape perimeter is also to be erected. See new updated rule 11.12

Prize money: ACA guidelines will be followed for prize money, see Rule 8 & 9(b)

Competitors to be neat and presentable at all times – Collared buttoned shirts (no t-shirts), boots, jeans/jodhpurs and hats or hard hats (no caps) will be allowed in competition

Cut-out Prize goes to go to one person, with the top cut-out. If equal score, there will be a run off.

If a competitor is not ready to compete after he or she has been called three (3) times they will be eliminated.

Novice Drafts competitors cannot ride the same horse in both drafts, one horse can only be nominated in one Novice Draft.

All competitors compete at their own risk. The committee reserve the right to alter/delete or change the order of the program, restrict campdraft entries if cattle numbers are insufficient. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint, must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint, if the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$20 fee is forfeited.
