- Arrangements have been made for OJD Monitored flocks to exhibit.
- All sheep to carry NLIS and Stud Ear Tags.
- All sheep must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- The judge is empowered to transfer sheep which he or she considers to be entered in the wrong class.
- Maximum of three entries per class per exhibitor.
- No prize winning entry shall leave the shed prior to 3.30pm otherwise Prizemoney is forfeited.
- Birth dates required on entry form for classes 1,2 6 & 7.
- All lambs over six months old must be shorn or cleanly clipped.
- All animals exhibited in class 11 must be entered in individual classes and be bred by the exhibitor.
